Check list

During submission of the manuscript, authors are expected to check the following to avoid rejection of the manuscript.

- Is your manuscript drafted according to the instruction to authors and should be typed in MS word but not as PDF or any other file?
- Is your manuscript has statistical analysis (for Research paper)?
- Spell out abbreviations on first use, followed by the abbreviation in parentheses, e.g., Butylated Hydroxy Toluene (BHT).
- Does our manuscript have abstract, key words? Abstract should not have any subheadings?
- All tables and figures should be at respective places, should be numbered consequently and should be cited or referred in the text.
- Each graph, figures and tables should have suitable title and appropriate legends. Foot notes (if necessary) should be present.
- X- axis and Y-axis of all graphs should have its name or label or title.
- Complete copy right form with the signature of the authors. You can down load the empty copy right form here.
- Figures should be of high resolution and good clarity.
- Scientific name of plants, animals, microorganisms etc should be italized.
- References should be as per Vancouver style. For details visit instructions to authors or click here.
- All references cited in the text should be in the reference section according to the cited numerical order.
- All language used should be accurate and precise. Active voice should be preferably used in most of the sentences.
